### **Who are we?**

### **How do we collect information from you?**

We obtain information about you when you complete our online enquiry form or contact us directly.

### **What type of information is collected from you?**

The information we have collected from you may include your phone number, date of birth, gender as well as IP address along with your email address.

### **IP Addresses**

We may collect information about your computer, including but not limited to (where available), your IP address, operating system and browser type for administration purposes and to produce internal reports.
